

+ Care and Maintenance Instructions for

Quartz material is naturally beautiful, durable, hygienic and easy to care for. It is easy to maintain because the combination of natural quartz crystals and polymers provides for a particularly smooth, non-porous and largely dirt-repellent surface. Moreover, the material is highly resistant to scratching. For long-lasting pleasure with your product, please make a note of the following instructions for care.

DAILY CLEANING

Removing light stains and marks:

Use a damp cloth and a neutral detergent, for example, an all-purpose cleansing agent, glass cleaner (alcohol-based without silicones), or a mild vinegar-based cleaner. Rinse the cleaners away afterward with clean water.

BASIC CLEANING + INTENSIVE CLEANING

Removing stubborn dirt and dried-on stains:

Use a low-abrasive scouring sponge (rough side without metal content) with a mild scouring agent (e.g. cleaning powder for ceramic glass cooktops). First remove encrustations with a plastic scraper avoiding high pressure in any one place. Always add sufficient liquid (water); never use an undiluted scouring agent.

1. Wash the worktop over a large area with warm water (avoid high rubbing pressure on any one point).
2. Rinse afterward with clear water.
3. Dry the surface with a clean, soft cloth or kitchen paper.

ADDITIONAL TIPS

- Do not use strong scouring or bleaching agents, colourants, battery acid, aggressive solvents, stains, hydrofluoric acid, Dichloromethane, caustic soda, paint remover or anything similar.
- If possible, use a cutting board for cutting work.
- For hot pots and pans, please use coasters.
